Thank you for expressing interest in the Jeanette and Oscar Cook JOIN program for the summer of 2017. Included in this link is an application for you to complete and return to JVS at your interview. All applicants must be full-time Jewish college students and residents of the metropolitan Detroit area.

The JOIN program is an eight-week student internship in a Jewish communal service agency. Each week, four days are spent working at an agency. In addition, interns attend a weekly seven-hour seminar to learn about the history and structure of the Jewish communal service agencies. Interns receive a \$2,960 stipend for participating in the program. The dates for the internship program are June 12 through August 4, 2017. Students must complete the entire internship during the dates specified.

If you have not already arranged a personal interview for the JOIN program, please call to schedule as soon as you complete the application. Personal interviews for the JOIN program will occur between December 2016 and January 31, 2017.

## **PROGRAM SUMMARY**

JVS is proud to announce that we will once again be coordinating the JOIN program for the summer of 2017 (June 12-August 4). "JOIN" is a summer internship program for Jewish full time undergraduate and graduate college students from metropolitan Detroit. It is designed to provide both a career and educational experience for participants. The purpose is to provide students with a professional work experience, a chance to "try out" possible careers, and to introduce participants to leadership roles within the community.

Students will be paid \$2,960 for the eight week program. Agencies that may have student interns include:

In addition to the four-day work week, students will be required to attend a weekly seven-hour seminar. These seminars include orientations to Jewish communal service agencies and discussions on related issues. Each week, time is set aside for the interns to share and assess their internship experiences. Interns will plan one of their seminar days to suit their specific interests.

Initial funding came from the Max Fisher Foundation of United Jewish Charities. In 1992, the Ben N. Teitel Charitable Trust pledged \$250,000 to JVS for the JOIN program in honor of Jeanette and Oscar Cook. Combining this gift with the generous support from JVS board members and the community, JVS established an endowment fund. The Jeanette and Oscar Cook JOIN program is now funded partially by the interest from the JVS Endowment Fund, and a portion of JVS' allocation from the Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Detroit (Allied Jewish Campaign). Funding for the JARC and the Kadima positions is from the Tony Richman Internship Scholarship Fund. Yad Ezra, Hillel Day School, University of Michigan Hillel, NCJW and the Holocaust Memorial Center independently fund their internships.
