

Seniors Assist Nonprofit Groups



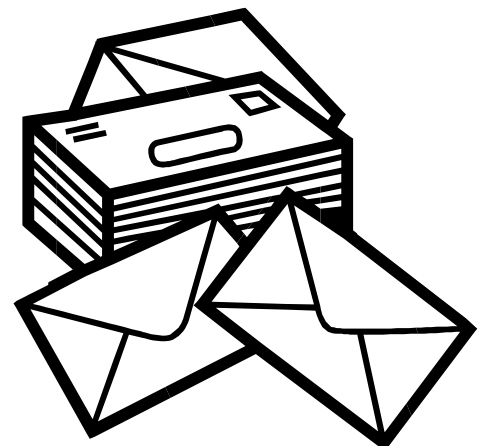
